WI TRAIL PASS – IT'S ALMOST HERE!

Re: WI Trail Pass Information

It's hard to believe but July 1, 2015 is right around the corner and that means the WI Trail Pass will finally become a reality!

The ways in which your current club member can obtain their discounted WI Trail Pass are:

- **Order online through the AWSC website** at www.awsc.org with a credit/debit card (MasterCard, Visa or Discover), your AWSC member # (found on your AWSC membership card or on the address label of your WSN magazine (Sept-March) and your WI snowmobile registration #. Members who order online will receive one receipt, via the email provided when ordering, from Authorize.Net (the credit card company we use to process our credit cards).
- **Call** the AWSC Office during business hours to order your WI Trail Pass with a credit/debit card, your AWSC member # along with your WI snowmobile registration #.
- **Walk in** the AWSC office door during business hours and order with a check or credit/debit card along with your AWSC member # and WI snowmobile registration #.
- **Mail in** with a check or credit/debit card along with your AWSC member # and your WI snowmobile registration # on the Trail Pass order form (enclosed) available from AWSC website or your Club Membership Chair. The order form will also be available in the September WSN magazine!

Remember it is up to your members to purchase their own discounted trail passes (\$10/per sled)!

Your job as Membership Chair –

- ✓ Be sure your members AWSC membership is current, as members must be current to receive a discounted trail pass.
- ✓ Your members address is correct in the AWSC database as the address we have in the database is where the Trail Pass will be mailed to. Only Membership Chair with authorized online access and the AWSC office can change a member's address.
- ✓ Does your member have his/her AWSC Member #? AWSC member #'s will be required to order discounted trail passes. AWSC member #'s are on the AWSC yellow membership card, on the address label of their WSN magazines (Sept-March) and on club rosters.

Things to Remember –

Your club has to have 10 or more dues paying members to be an eligible club for the discounted trail pass.

Snowmobiles must be registered in WI. **Please note:** For newly purchased snowmobiles with registration pending, please call the AWSC office.

Your receipt for the discounted pass cannot be used to ride – the sticker has to be on windshield (or center of hood if you change windshields).

All Trail Pass stickers will be mailed via USPO from the State of WI.

The fine for riding without a WI Trail Pass is - **\$250**.

There will be no refunds or exchanges.

The WI Trail Pass (2015-2016) will be good from July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016.

Next year's Trail Pass will be effective July 1, 2016 and so forth.

Please remember to check our website to be sure we have the correct contact information for your club as non club members may be looking to join your club!

Press Releases in your local papers will be helpful so the non club members are aware of the change and know how to join your club!

Thank you in advance for your help and patience as we guide our members through this long overdue and important change in Wisconsin snowmobiling.
