

ATV/UTV Ordinance Project Outline for Town of Quincy

- 1) Form a committee
- 2) Devise a strategy for ATV/UTV's for approval by the Town of Quincy's town board
- 3) Create a timeline
- 4) Create a project task list for project coordination and management
- 5) How do we communicate this project out to the community?
- 6) Continue to promote the Town of Quincy as a recreation & tourist community
- 7) Seek help from outside the community (WATVA, communities that allow ATV/UTV, State Senator, State Legislator for our area)
- 8) Do we retain an attorney?
- 9) Research liability
- 10) Insurance
- 11) Develop and create a road route
 - a) requirements for signing the road route
 - b) costs for signing the road route
- 12) Would the club be willing to pay for the signing? Even though we are being over taxed by the town and they state the normal response that, they have no money. Are there funds or grants available from the state?
- 13) Signed petitions
- 14) Impact to the community with approval of ATV/UTV's
 - a) All businesses in town, County Park, recreation, tourism
 - b) Home sales and new home builds for this recreation area. This town has zero growth!
- 15) Writing an ordinance for the Town of Quincy for presentation to them for ATV/UTV's
- 16) Presenting our finalized proposal/final report to the town board for approval and a vote
- 17) A mailing campaign from the town of Quincy's 'tax payers' (both permanent and part-time residents) to the town chairman and board of directors urging them to vote 'YES'. We stress 'tax payers' because some of us are not allowed to vote in Quincy. We vote at our permanent residence
- 18) If ordinance for ATV/UTV's 'doesn't pass', create a strategic plan for moving forward
