# AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ATV/UTV VEHICLE ROUTES AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF ATV/UTV VEHICLES

# Section I – Intent

The Town of Quincy, Adams County adopts the following ATV/UTV vehicle route for the operation of ATV/UTV vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due considerations of recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this route(s) has been created.

## Section II – Statutory Authority

This route is created pursuant to town authority under section 1.1.01 as authorized by 23.33 (8) (b), Wis. Stats.

The applicable provisions of 23.33 regulating ATV/UTV operation pursuant to routes are adopted

#### Section III – Routes

The following roads are designated as routes.

- A. Birch Ave. west to Blackhawk St.
- B. Blackhawk St. south to Dell Ave.
- C. Dell Ave. west to Town Rd.
- D. Dell Ave. east to Deerborn Dr.
- E. Deerborn Dr. east to 18<sup>th</sup>. Ave.
- F. 18<sup>th</sup>. Ave. south to Dyke Ave.
- G. Town Rd. south to Rito Ave.
- H. Rito Ave west to Market St.
- I. Market St. south to Kendtorff Ave.

- J. Kendtorff east to Olmstead St.
- K. Olmstead St. south to Kraft Ave.
- L. Kraft Ave. east to Town Rd.
- M. Town Rd. South to Dover Dr.
- N. Dover Dr. east to 18<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- O. Dyke Ave. west
- P. Edgewood Ave. west to 19<sup>th</sup> Dr.
- Q. Edgewood Ave. east to 16<sup>th</sup> Dr.
- R. 16<sup>th</sup> Dr. south to Evergreen Ave.
- S. Evergreen Ave. west
- T. Evergreen Ave. east to the end of Town of Quincy line

## Section IV – Conditions

As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers);

- A. All ATV/UTV operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits.
- B. All ATV/UTV operators shall ride single file.
- C. All ATV/UTV operators shall slow the vehicle to 10 mph or less when operating within 150 feet of a dwelling.
- D. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12 and NR 64.12(7)c.

## Section V – Enforcement

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the state of Wisconsin.

# Section VI – Penalties

Wisconsin state ATV/UTV Vehicle penalties as found in s. 23.33 (13) (a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

## Section VII – Severability

The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Quincy would have passed the other provisions of this ordnance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

# Section VIII – Effective Date

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
